Subject: Proposal from Viet Nam "Seafarers must be a priority for Covid 19 vaccines"

First of all, we would like to send our most sincere and deepest thanks to the International Maritime Organisation (IMO) and to IMO Secretary General, Mr. Kitack Lim in particular, for the efforts and contributions to the cause of safety, security and environmental protection of the global maritime and shipping industry as a whole, particularly of member countries in relation to the prevention of the Covid 19 pandemic.

We absolutely agree with your message for Seafarers in Covid 19 pandemic with respect to "Designating all seafarers and marine personnel (not only nationals) within their jurisdiction as key workers providing an essential service.", since the unique and essential work of seafarers for international shipping and for the world with the uninterrupted transportation of vital medical supplies, food and other basic necessities during the pandemic.

In the face of the current complicated developments of the pandemic, in order to ensure absolute safety for seafarers and marine personel, national key workers, to maintain the continuity of the global supply chain, Vietnam would like to recommend to the Secretary-General some of the following proposals:

- Member States' governments should have the policy of directing all their national seafarers and marine personel to be on the priority list for the full Covid 19 vaccines.
